FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

1. How future-ready is the school?

Ans:- Our school emphasizes on personalized and robust student-centred learning environment where the student learns in and out of traditional school settings. For this purpose, we have our own STEM Park. AI, Robotics, and Coding are integrated into with the curriculum starting from primary classes. The school believes that a healthy mind resides in a healthy body for this a special commando training park has also been created for the students to explore.

2. Is there any Robotics & Tinkering Lab in the school?

Ans:- Yes, we have robotics & tinkering lab in our regular timetable for classes 3 to 8 for the students who are enthusiastic about technology.

3. Is foreign language taught in the school?

Ans: Yes, we have French language in our regular curriculum for classes 3 to 5 and optional for the 3rd language with Sanskrit.

4. How skilled are the teachers?

Ans:- Our teachers are well qualified and strive hard to keep themselves abreast of the latest developments in the field of education. They are Microsoft Certified and attend the relevant CBSE seminars & webinars to keep in stride with the changing times. The teachers are highly experienced in CBSE checking/ evaluation/ supervision.

5. Does learning happen outside the classroom?

Ans:- The School has highly equipped labs for all the subjects. We have language lab, Social Science Composite lab, Maths Lab, Science Labs (Physics, Chemistry & Biology). We have junior and senior lab separately for Computer Science.

6. Does learning happen outside the textbooks?

Ans:- We strongly believe in "Blended learning with technology integration". Keeping in sync with this motto learning is done through gamification, Art integration, experiential learning and out of the box activities. The students are also encouraged to participate in various subject Olympiads / competitions at state, national and international level.

7. How safe are the learning spaces?

Ans:- The entire school area is under CCTV surveillance 24*7. The school has active POCSO committee, School Disaster Management Committee and School Safety Committee.

8. How is technology used in the school?

Ans:- The school has embraced technology in every domain. We have a dedicated ERP App for our school. It has been over a decade the school has functional Digital Classrooms. The Digital Classrooms laced with latest softwares open the window of the world for the students.

9. How are the students assessed?

Ans:- A Continuous and comprehensive system of assessment is followed throughout the year wherein they are assessed on progress on core concept, High Order Thinking Skills and their applications. Rote memorization and cramming is discouraged.

10. Are involvements and achievements outside academics encouraged and supported?

Ans:- Our school encourages and bolsters students to participate on a mass level in national & international competitions organized by CBSE, DOE, Sahodaya etc. Specialized training in Team sports like Volley ball, basketball and individual games like badminton, athletics, and taekwondo is provided in the school.

11. What is the value system of the school?

12. Is there a change in school uniform for academic session 2023-24?

Ans:- No, there is no change in the school uniform, the school form goes in a structure of PS to 2 / 3 to 8 / 9 to 12. New uniform was introduced in the academic year 2020-2021.

13. If I want to opt out after the completion of current academic year, what are the formalities to follow?

Ans:- You need to apply a formal application for SLC addressed to the Principal at the school reception to Mr. Suresh before 1 March 2023.

14. Will I get academic assistance from teachers for the month of April 2023 after applying for SLC and not paying fees for the month of April 2023?

Ans:- No, you would not get any assistance from teachers if you have applied for SLC. After Final Exams student will not be considered on the rolls of the school.

15. If I apply for SLC in the month of March and I change my mind to continue in the same school, what will be the procedure to be followed?

Ans:- You have to take Fresh Admission Procedure.

In that case, fees for the new session (April 2023 to March 2024) will be charged as according to Govt. rules and other charges.

16. What is the fee structure for Pre-School to X for the academic session 2023-24?

17. Is it mandatory to pay quarterly fees?

Ans: Yes is it better to pay the fees quarterly for smooth functioning of the school and to manage your own budget better. But if you want to pay monthly fees that is also permissible. According to school rules it is mandatory to pay last quarter fees in the month of January before 10th Date.

18. Rule 164 –Fees payable for twelve months-

All fees and funds shall be charged for a full period of twelve months, from the students at the rates specified in these rules except in the following case namely:-
a student, who has been expelled or rusticated during a session shall not be required to pay fees and funds beyond the month in which he was expelled or rusticated;

19. Rule 165. - Last date for payment of fees and contributions before 10th date of each month-

All fees and contributions payable to a school by a student shall be payable by the 10th day of the month in which they are due:

Provided that where the school remains closed on the 10th day of the month, such fees of contributions shall be payable on the date following the 10th day on which the school reopens :

Provided further that where the school remains closed for the long vacation, fees and contributions shall be payable within ten days from the day on which the school re-opens after the long vacation.

20. Rule 166. Fine for late payment of fees, etc.-

A fine for late payment of the fees or contributions due to a school shall be charged from the student at the rate of ₹10 for every day, after the 10th, for which the default continues.
